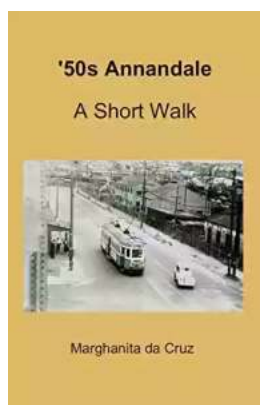

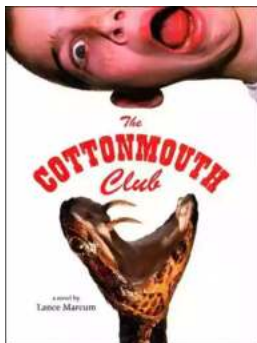
On 9 September 2017, Marghanita da Cruz was elected to the Inner West Council.

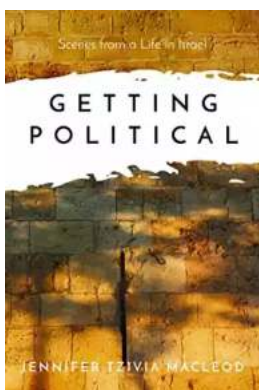
