

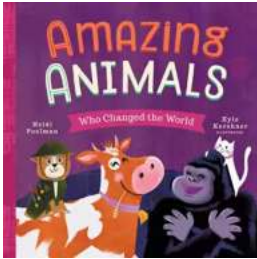
# Amazing Animals Who Changed The World

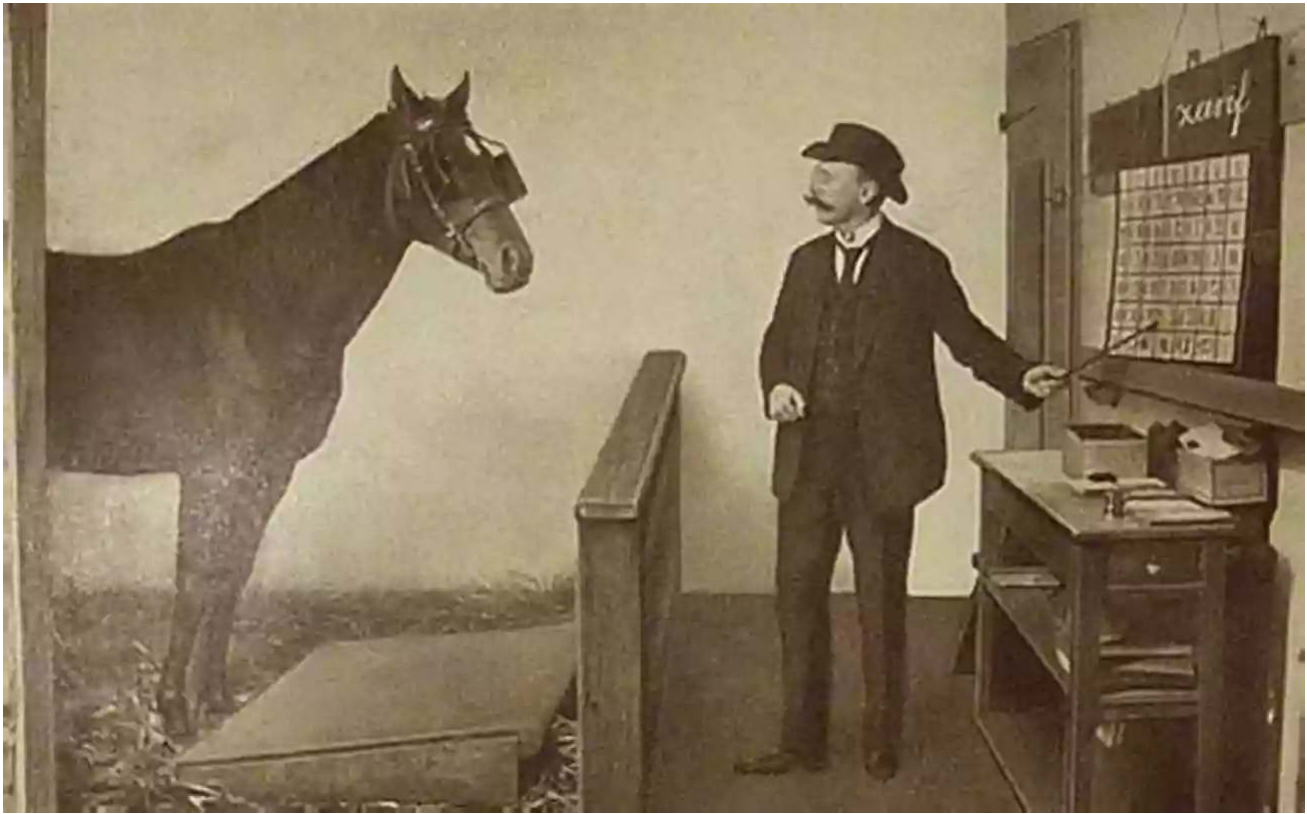


## 2. Balto - Delivering Lifesaving Serum
