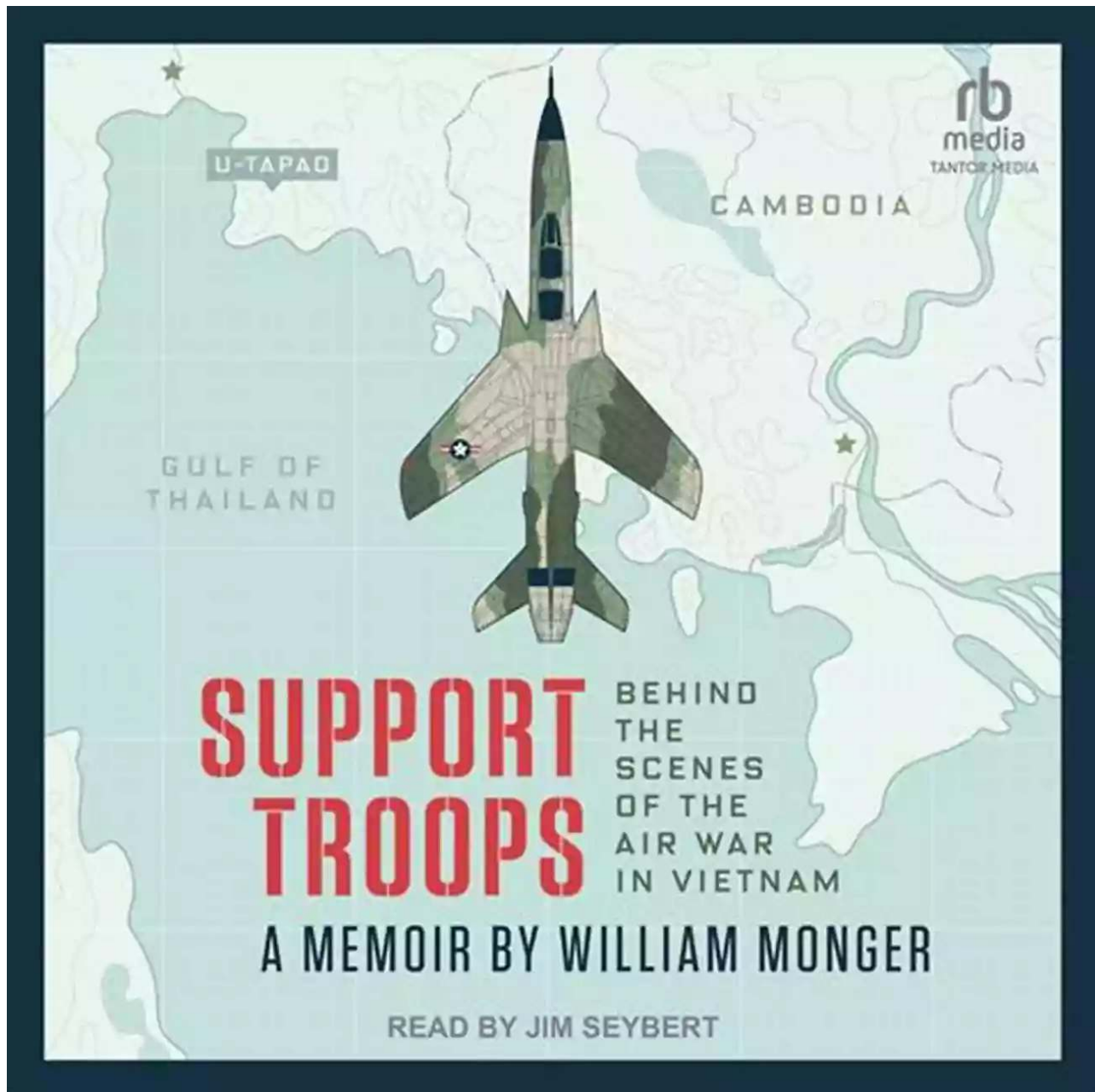

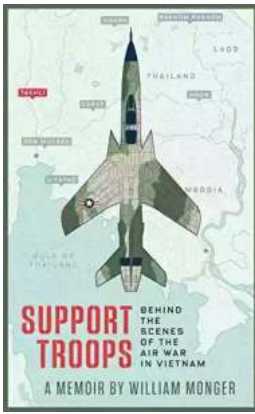

They may not be getting shot at or shelled, but they are vital to the mission in every sense.

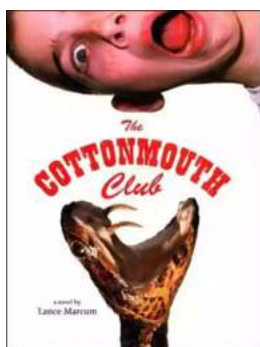

They, too, serve their country honorably. This story is dedicated to support personnel serving everywhere, past, and present.



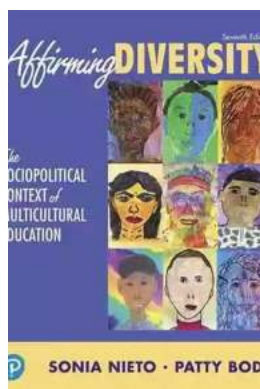
