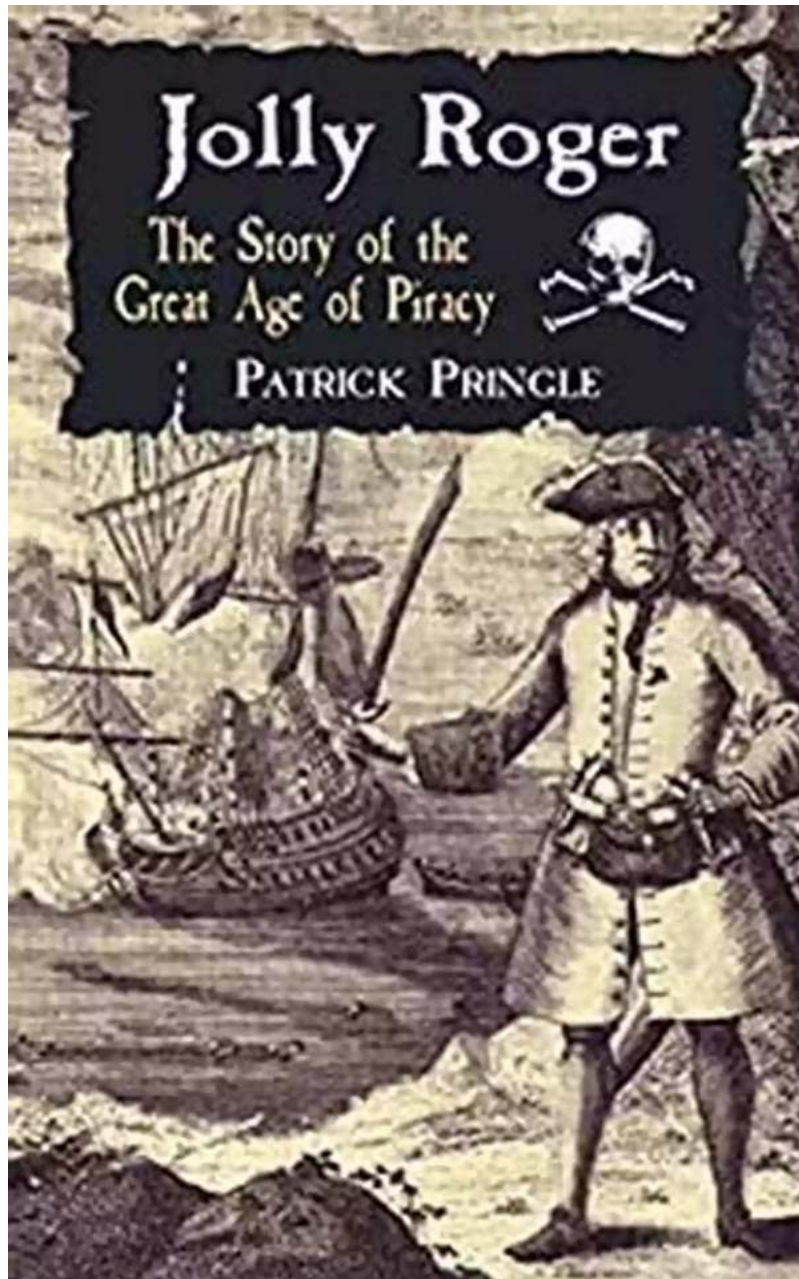

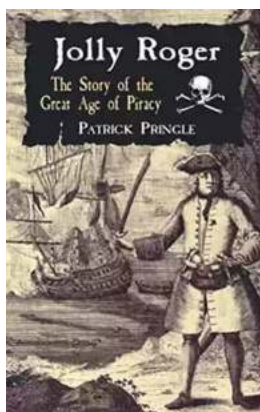

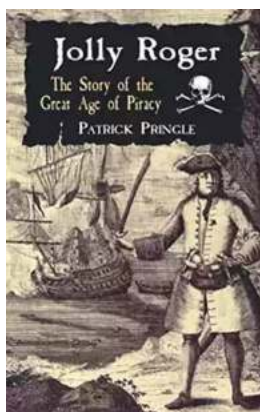

Pirates, for example, never made their prisoners walk the plank. This was a nineteenth-century fiction with no basis in reality.
